During the September, 1999 membership meeting, a motion was made and seconded to purchase an engine and finance the purchase by selling non interest bearing shares in the engine.

During the September, 2000 membership meeting, a motion was made and seconded to purchase an engine using the funds raised from the sale of those non interest bearing bonds. The engine selected was an SW1500 and Slug from Rail Systems, Inc.

The engine was ordered in late October and we have a tentative delivery date of mid April. Those people coming to help put the track in order may get to help do some trial runs with our new engine.
